The role of dispensing pharmacies, and consultant pharmacists, has evolved to be a significant member of the skilled nursing community care delivery team. With recent changes, and more changes planned in Phase 2, proactive SNF administrative, and clinical, teams can leverage their existing pharmacy and pharmacist partnerships to meet new regulatory requirements, while they exceed resident care outcomes.

This session will examine the Phase 1 changes, explore the Phase 2 changes – including the role of the pharmacist in a highly effective antimicrobial stewardship program – and provide examples of best practice policies and procedures. Specific implementation strategies will be discussed to assist communities in early adoption prior to the November 28, 2017 compliance deadline.
