



## **Annual Scholarship Sponsorship Opportunities**

The Indiana Health Care Foundation (IHCF) is a 501(c)3 organization that furthers knowledge, education, information, and understanding in the areas of health care, wellness, and services to the aged and chronically ill. More specifically, the IHCF provides financial support to individuals seeking to improve skills in the area of workforce development, education, and training related to the long term care profession.

Indiana, like many parts of the country, is facing a critical shortage of health care professionals, particularly clinicians, at a time when the state's baby boomer population is rapidly approaching an age in which they will require skilled nursing, assisted living, or home-based care. In an effort to curb this shortage and increase the number of well-trained health care professionals able to provide care to the growing geriatric population, the IHCF works each year to increase our funding for scholarships for these individuals.

Since 1997, IHCF has offered a variety of clinical, administrative and support staff scholarships to qualified individuals pursuing higher and continuing education in long term care. IHCF solicits scholarship applications on an annual basis and those applications are vetted by members of the Scholarship Committee, which is comprised of professionals with experience in the long term care profession. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the educational institution offering the course, rather than the individual.

Our scholarship opportunities evolve as the needs of long term care professionals grow. Current scholarship opportunities include:

- Certified Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Care Trainer Certification Scholarship through the National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners
- Multiple LPN/RN Degree Scholarships for those accepted to certified Indiana nursing programs
- Health Facility Administrator/Residential Care Administrator Scholarships
- Social Service Designee Scholarship
- Wound Management Certification Scholarships through the Wound Care Education Institute
- Nurse Aide Train-the -Trainer Scholarships
- HOSA Scholarships - Available to student members of Indiana HOSA high school and collegiate chapters
