- Differentiate between wound etiologies and clinical manifestations of acute and traumatic wounds.
- Differentiate types of burns and principles of management.
- Select treatment options and differentiate wound etiologies and clinical manifestations of chronic, malignant, and inflammatory wounds.
- Discuss 3 adjunctive treatment modalities that enhance wound healing.
- Discuss current multidisciplinary care approaches to wound care.
- Discuss components required for accurate wound documentation.

Examination Eligibility

Those wishing to take the Wound Care Certified (WCC®) or Nutrition Wound Care Certified (NWCC®) board certification exam must take the NAWCO® approved training course, plus hold an active unrestricted license in one of the following professions:

- LPN/LVN, RN, NP, PA, OTA, OT, PT, PTA, MD, DO, DPM—2 years full time or 4 years part time where wound care was a component of the job duties in the past 5 years
- RD/RDN—practiced 1 year full time or 2 years part time
