Eligibility Criteria

Sites must be reviewed for eligibility prior to approval. BinaxNOW approval will be based on the following criteria:

- * Have a CLIA waiver or partner with an entity that does.
- * Able to complete the training and documentation.
- * Able to report results via REDCap.
- * Have a source for their collection supplies and PPE.
- * Have demonstrated a quantifiable need based on a facility outbreak.
- * Unable to provide outbreak testing with current testing capacity

Request Process

1. Review the training documents.
2. Email Andrea Thurlow (athurlow@isdh.in.gov) and Sara Blosser (sblosser@isdh.in.gov) with any questions you have about the cards, their use or reporting.
3. Submit a [213 RR](#) form to isdhdeplotistics@isdh.in.gov to request the cards. Make sure you include:
 - * Name, email address, phone number of requestor.
 - * Name of the long-term care facility.
 - * Name, email address, phone number of the delivery point-of-contact.
 - * Address where the kits would be delivered.
 - * CLIA ID number and expiration date.

Reminders

1. Testing can only be performed in a CLIA-certified laboratory (e.g. CLIA waiver).
2. Allocation is a standard 2 case (1,280 tests) allocation in a first come, first served basis. Because this is a limited resource, the Indiana Department of Health can only fulfil one request per requesting entity at this time.
3. Deliveries are organized only once a week.
