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# FYI – Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage

- ABN Form CMS-R-131 and instructions approved by OMB for renewal.
- The use of the renewed form with the expiration date of 01/31/2026 will be mandatory on 6/30/23.
- You may continue to use the ABN form with expiration date of 6/30/23 until the renewed form (expiration date 1/31/26) becomes mandatory on 6/30/23.
- Note: SNFs issue the ABN to transfer potential financial liability for items/services expected to be denied under Medicate Part B only.

# Director of food and nutrition services

- October 1, 2023 deadline for compliance with food and nutrition director requirements.
- CMS added to the requirements for the director of food and nutrition services at §483.60(a)(2)(E) as part of the 2023 SNF PPS rule published in August 2022.

# Director of food and nutrition continued

- CMS added an additional pathway to qualify for the position;
  - Includes having <u>two or more years of experience</u> in the <u>position of director of food and nutrition services</u> in a <u>nursing facility setting</u> and has <u>completed a course of</u> <u>study in food safety and management</u>, by no later than <u>October 1, 2023</u>

### Continued

- CMS has noted that the course requirements would be the equivalent of a ServSafe Food Manager certification.
- Must complete the required training before October 1, 2023, to qualify for the role.

#### **Considerations**

 An assistant director, supervisor, or manager of food and nutrition services or other related titles/roles can qualify as having 2 or more years of experience in the position of director if the individual's defined role and the duties they performed in that role comply with the requirements.

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### **Considerations**

- The requirement to have two or more years of experience in the position noted can have occurred at any point before the final rule effective October 1, 2022.
- Facilities that qualify as "nursing facility setting" can vary – experience should support the ability to serve in position in the long-term care setting.



#### **PHE – Telehealth -- HIPAA**

- Congress extended many telehealth coverage flexibilities – permanently or until December 31, 2024
- A policy change will no longer permit providers to use technology such as unsecure iPads, smart phones, or other technology for telehealth services unless they meet stringent HIPAA patient privacy requirements after August 9, 2023.


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
#### Transition


- The Office for Civil Rights is providing a 90- calendar day transition period for providers to come into compliance with HIPAA Rules related to telehealth.
- Transition period May 12, 2023, and will expire at 11:59 p.m. on August 9, 2023.

### **Recommendations**

- Evaluate telehealth services used in your facility
- Update policies and procedures, equipment, and arrangements related to telehealth services.
- Evaluate equipment and software technology using for telehealth services and vendor arrangements.
- Do this now before August 9, 2023.






