### **Updates Regarding Novavax**

### Novavax - COVID-19 Vaccine

- Ordering of Novavax COVID-19 vaccine (NDC 80631-0100-10) will end during the second half of the week starting April 3 (final date/time TBD).
- Please note that all viable doses of Novavax currently available have an expiration date of April 30, 2023.
- Doses ordered from now until when ordering ends will be short dated.
- There will be no shelf-life extensions for this product.

#### **Recommended Actions:**

- Remove expired vaccine vials immediately from storage units to avoid inadvertently administering them. Expired vaccine should NEVER be administered.
- 2. Discard the vaccine according to the manufacture's guidance, state and federal regulations.
- 3. Update their inventory of Novavax in Vaccine Finder. The current NDC of this vaccine should no longer be listed as in stock after April 30, 2023 (i.e., available doses should be zero).

### What happens now?

In order to have a non-mRNA COVID-19 vaccine available through the summer, an offering of a 5-dose vial presentation of Novavax COVID-19 vaccine (NDC 80631-0102-01), which contains ten 5 dose vials per carton.

Minimum order is 100 doses.

Expiration of new Novavax presentation will be 10/31/23

The timing of availability for this new presentation is the same date/time that the existing Novavax is turned off for ordering. This week!



# CMS Updates for Skilled Nursing Facilities

- CMS released a proposed rule updating Medicare payment policies and rates for skilled nursing facilities on April 4, 2023. – Not yet published
  - CMS estimates the proposed rate changes will result in a net increase of 3.7% or about 1.2 billion in Part A payments to providers in FY 2024 includes net market basket of 2 billion increase.



# CMS Updates for SNF – continued

- Changes to PDPM ICD-10 code mappings
- Allow facilities to receive by default the 35 percent penalty reduction when the facility has not appealed withing the 60-day timeframe. If finalized, this would reduce paperwork and no longer require a written waiver of a hearing to appeal deficiencies that lead to the imposition of a CMP.
- The proposed rule did not include minimum staffing requirements.
   CMS is reviewing feedback related to minimum staffing requirements
  - proposals likely in the spring



### Continued

- SNF Quality Reporting Program proposed changes include:
  - Adoption of Discharge Function Score Measure
  - Adoption of the CoreQ: Short /stay Discharge Measure
  - Adoption of the COVID-19 Vaccine % of Residents Who are Up To Date Measure
  - Modify the COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage for HCP measure
  - Removal of three measures beginning in FY 2025
  - Raising the completion threshold to 90% for all MDS assessments submitted to CMS must contain 100% of required data items. Failure to do so will result in 2 percentage points to the applicable fiscal year payment update beginning with FY 2026.
  - FY 2025 removal of three measures



### Continued

- SNF Value-Based Purchasing (VBP) Program for FY 2024 and beyond – proposed changes:
  - Adoption of the following:
    - Nurse Staff Turnover Measure
    - Discharge Function Score Measure
    - Long Stay Hospitalization Measure per 100 residents
    - Percent of Residents Experiencing One or More Falls with Major Injury Long Stay Measure
    - Health Equity Adjustment that rewards SNFs who perform well and whose resident population is at least 20% dual eligibility status.

### What has changed?

CMPs (Civil Money Penalty) will no longer apply for all F880 infection control citations.

CMP would apply if the scope and severity was cited at a G or higher.

Enhanced enforcement (Directed POC and DDPNA), would only be enforced at Level 2 (D,E,&F) when **BOTH** F880-Infection Prevention & Control – and F887- COVID-19 Immunizations were cited.

CMS reduced the times to achieve substantial compliance. Compliance must be achieved in 30 days for a Level 2 (D, E, & F) deficiency and 15 days for a Level 3 (G, H, & I) or 4 (J, K, L) deficiency.
