
#### **Start Preparing for Fall Vaccinations**

### **Regualtory Considerations**

- COVID 19 vaccination is no longer required for nursing home staff.
- CMS certified nursing facilities are required to report both Influenza Vaccination Coverage among Health Care Personnel and COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage among Healthcare Personnel to the National Health and Safety Network NHSN – requirements of SNF Reporting Program.

### **Practical Considerations**

- Respiratory season can be dangerous for older adults with underlying health conditions
- Elderly individuals living in a nursing home and assisted living communities are at higher risk of complications due to respiratory illnesses.



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- When a SNF fails to submit the required quality data, the SNF will be subject to a two percentage (2%) point reeducation in the Annual Payment Update for the applicable performance year.
  - CMS is providing notification to facilities that were deemed to be out of compliance with Quality Reporting Program (QRP) requirements for CY 2022, which will affect FY 2024 Annual Payment Update (APU).
  - The Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) are providing the notifications placed into My Reports folders in iQIES for SNFs on July 20, 2023.
  - Facilities that receive a letter of non-compliance may submit a request for reconsideration to CMS via email no later than 11:59 pm, August 18, 2023.
  - SNF Quality Reporting Reconsideration and Exception & Extension
