CMS COVID Outbreak Referrals

• Since March 2020, Qsource has received over a 1000 COVID outbreak referrals in Long-Term-Care (LTC) facilities across the state of Indiana.

- Initial contact to gather preliminary information about the outbreak
- Scheduled site visit
- What to expect during the site visit
- Building an ongoing partnership with follow up support

Frequent Question



- Do providers need to continue to "Educate and Offer" COVID-19 vaccination to residents/clients and staff.
- Rules remain in effect until May 2024 unless further action taken by CMS.
- You must continue to educate and offer COVID-19 vaccination to residents and staff as part of the Requirements of Participation.

COVID-19 Tests - Free



Department of Health and Human Services Abbott BinaxNOW Test Kit Program. Assisted Living and SNF are eligible for monthly shipments Must have active CLIA waiver to be eligible Shipments started and stopped, and test quantities can be increased or decreased by emailing <u>TDX@hhs.gov</u> Email must include the following:

Name of facility Facility Address CLIA Waiver # Request – STOP/START, INCREASE, DECREASE
