Paxlovid - Useful links



1. PAXCESS Patient Support Program

PAXCESS Patient Support Program (iassist.com)

PAXCESS™ | PAXLOVID™ (nirmatrelvir tablets; ritonavir tablets)

- Co-pay savings: Eligible commercially insured patients can save up to \$1,500 per prescription.

 Maximum annual savings up to \$1,500.
 - Through December 31, 2024, individuals covered under federal programs, such as Medicare or Medicaid, and uninsured patients are eligible for the USG Patient Assistance Program (PAP)
 operated by Pfizer and can receive Paxlovid at no cost.

Paxlovid - Useful links



- 2. Treatment locator Treatment Locator (hhs.gov)
- 3. Home test to treat:
 - Individuals who are uninsured, rely on Medicare, Medicaid, or VA insurance, or receive care
 from Indian Health Services can receive free access to COVID-19 and flu testing, telehealth, and
 treatment through the Home Test to Treat program Home (test2treat.org). Can sign up before
 testing for flu or COVID-19. If they test positive, participants can receive free telehealth care
 and medication for COVID-19 and/or flu, if prescribed
 - For those who are privately insured or have employer-sponsored healthcare: They are eligible to enroll with a current positive COVID-19 and/or flu test, can receive free telehealth care and medication for COVID-19 and/or flu, if prescribed. Not eligible to receive free tests.
 - Treatment can be shipped to the individual or picked up at a local pharmacy at no cost for those eligible

Assisted Living – Call to Action

The US Senate Special Committee on Aging held a hearing –
 Assisted Living Facilities: Understanding Long-Term Care Options for Older Adults

In follow-up, assisted living residents and families have been asked to use their voice and share their stories and experiences by submitting those.

Joint Employer Rule



- National Labor Relation Board (NLRB) issued a final rule
 - Broadens the definition of employer
 - This rule replaces the 2020 final rule
 - The new final rule of 2023 becomes effective 2/26/24
 - Some groups are fighting this and allege the rule is unlawful and should be struck down.
 - Employers should prepare to comply in case that does not happen.
- Contract staff or a staffing agency use you need to pay attention
 - Are they unionized?
 - Non- supervisory staff?
 - Covered by section 7 of NLR Act ? even if not unionized

Joint Employer Rule



- When two entities are found to be joint employers you both could be held liable for labor law violations and bargaining obligation.
 - If you use staffing agencies or contract workers a recommended action is to review the rule carefully and seek counsel to assess your risks if this rule sticks.

OSHA Reporting – New Requirements



- 100 or more employees
- In designated high hazard industries (listed in Appendix B to Subpart E of 29 CFR Part 1904) – see attachment
 - 6231 Nursing Care Facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities)
 - 6232 Residential IDD, Mental Health and Substance Abuse Facilities
 - 6233 Continuing Care Retirement Communities, Assisted Living Facilities for the Elderly
 - 6239 Other Residential Care Facilities

Must electronically submit to OSHA detailed information about each recordable injury and illness entered on their previous calendar year's OSHA Form 300 Log Form 301 Incident Report (29 CFR 1904.41)

OSHA Reporting – New Requirements



- What data is included in the new required report?
 - Date
 - Physical location
 - Severity of the injury or illness
 - Details about the worker who was injured
 - Details about how the injury or illness occurred

Data must be electronically submitted through OSHA's Injury Tracking Application (ITA). – There are 3 ways to submit the data – see handout

ITA began accepting 2023 injury and illness data on January 2, 2024. Due date to complete submission is March 2, 2024.

Submission requirement is annual and deadline for timely submission of previous year's injury and illness data will be March 2 of each year.

COVID-19 Tests - Free



Department of Health and Human Services Abbott BinaxNOW Test Kit Program.

Assisted Living and SNF are eligible for monthly shipments Must have active CLIA waiver to be eligible Shipments started and stopped, and test quantities can be increased or decreased by emailing TDX@hhs.gov Email must include the following:

Name of facility
Facility Address
CLIA Waiver #
Request – STOP/START, INCREASE, DECREASE
